Main role and function

Do you want to facilitate youth engagement and awareness on rewilding in your country? The EYR National Contacts are part of the EYR Volunteer Team and are local point of reference and contact for young rewilders in a specific country. The ambition is that the National EYR Officer will facilitate on-the-ground rewilding activities (with a focus on information and awareness) aimed at young people. This role is carried out mainly online.

Main responsibilities

- Be a contact point between the EYR coordinator and young people that want to engage or initiate rewilding activities/actions in the given country.
- Connect with local communities and organizations to facilitate rewilding initiatives for young people.
- Communicate regularly with the EYR coordinator.
- Direct and provide information for young people in a specific country which are interested in rewilding.
- Organize meetups or other types of activities when feasible.
- Promote and share info about Rewilding Europe's work.
- Ensure cohesiveness of information within young rewilders of the given country.

Profile

- You are between 18 and 30 years old.
- You have good knowledge in rewilding.
- You have excellent spoken and written English and the language of the country you are applying for.
- You have some relevant local contacts and/or an overview of the national and/or local youth environmental network or are willing to get it.
- You are proactive and know how to engage with people and harness their enthusiasm into practice.
- You are reliable.
- You are able to commit around 3-5 hours per week to the role.
- ... but mostly, you support and share the rewilding vision!
